## **Terms and Conditions**

**Program:** This program deals with the filling and sealing of abandoned wells as a means of protecting the

groundwater aquifer from potential contamination.

**Objective:** As abandoned wells threaten groundwater quality, and pose a variety of safety concerns in many

areas, the aim of this program is to identify and properly seal the many wells left open and abandoned throughout the Conservation District, thereby protecting the quality of groundwater into

the future.

**Eligibility:** Open abandoned wells within the Inter-Mountain Watershed District are eligible under this

program.

**Assistance:** Costs directly pertaining to the sealing of the abandoned well identified in this application will be

covered by the Inter-Mountain Watershed District, with the exception of flowing artesian

wells which may qualify for a reimbursement of \$600/well on proof of payment.

Note: The decision as to whether or not to undertake a project will be left up to the discretion of the board and staff of the IMWD. Should access to the site of any abandoned well be an issue, the construction of any necessary access route shall be the responsibility of the landowner/applicant.

## **General Information:**

- All projects to be approved by the IMWD prior to construction and are subject to available funding.
- The Watershed District shall determine application priorities in consultation with Sub-district, Board and Staff.
- All necessary approvals will need to be in place prior to construction.
- Engineering and technical service for project design and construction will be subject to the availability of funding and/or staff. The Inter-Mountain Watershed District reserves the right to establish priorities for providing such services and assistance.
- IMWD reserves the right for reasonable access to the project site for inspection and to promote the program.
