**RECOMMENDED TREE AND SHRUB SPACING**

*Deciduous trees* - at least 2m (6 ft) apart

*Deciduous shrubs* - approx 1m (3 ft) apart.

*Coniferous trees* - at least 3m (10ft) apart

**Trees come in bundles of 10. Full payment is required at time of application – cash, cheque or e-transfer is accepted. Taxes included in price. Application deadline February 28<sup>th</sup>.**

**TREE QUANTITY CALCULATION EXAMPLE**

Distance of planting (m/ft) divided by selected species spacing equals total trees required # of bundles required (500 ÷ 10/bundle)

## Terms and Conditions

### Objective:

- To provide young tree seedlings for large plantings within Inter-Mountain Watershed District (IMWD); these plantings will provide environmental benefits to the area.
- Large tree planting projects can be expensive; IMWD is able to obtain cost savings by compiling all individual tree orders and buying in bulk.
- Landowner is responsible for preparing the site, planting the trees, and all maintenance of trees and site. Tree seedlings/cuttings are 6–24 inches in height at time of delivery. IMWD does not provide warranty on tree seedlings and cuttings.
- Machines for larger tree plantings and plastic mulch applications are available for rental. IMWD also has larger trees available from the IMWD Tree Nursery for Municipal plantings (please contact our office).
- Planting site must be located within the Inter-Mountain Watershed District. IMWD area includes:

### General Information:

- Orders for trees are taken up until the Feb.28th deadline. Full payment must accompany the application. Cash or cheques are accepted.
- No change in orders or refunds are considered once the order has been placed by the IMWD with our tree supplier. Due to the nature of the tree nursery business there may be instances where the IMWD is unable to supply the order requested. In these instances, the purchaser can either take a substitution of stock of equal value or a refund.
- Tree seedlings are expected to be received between May 1st and May 15th. Seedling pickup dates will be determined by the IMWD and all applicants will be notified. Pick up is at the Ethelbert IMWD office (Hwy 274 just outside of Ethelbert).
- Any seedlings purchased but not picked up on the pickup dates, will revert to the property of the IMWD unless prior arrangements have been made. No refunds will be issued.
- IMWD does not provide warranty on tree seedlings.
- Applicant will indemnify and save harmless the IMWD, their agents, engineers, servants and /or employees from any liability that may result from this project.
- IMWD reserves the right for reasonable access to the project site for inspection and to promote the program.
